UJALA, an acronym for Unnat Jyoti by Affordable LEDs for All, is being implemented by Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL).

Which Company is implementing This Scheme

EESL has already distributed over 15.41 crore (as on 2nd Sept. 2016) LED bulbs across the country resulting in energy savings of more than 5.48 crore KWh every day (as on 2nd Sept. 2016) and has helped avoid peak demand of over 4,007 MW (as on 2nd Sept. 2016).

This has helped in reduction of over 4,415 tonnes of CO2 per day (as on 2nd Sept. 2016) which is estimated to have a cost savings of Rs 21.94 Crore per day (as on 2nd Sept. 2016).
